Lenin Rodriguez is a research scholar in Horticulture & Crop Science on wheat breeding.

Alejandra Jimenez Madrid is a PhD candidate in Plant Pathology, working with Dr. Melanie Lewis Ivey researching the prevalence and characterization of streptomycin resistance *Erwinia amylovora* in Ohio apple orchards and identifying new alternatives, such as biocontrol, to manage fire blight disease.

Ana Trabanino is an M.S. student, working with Dr. Andy Michel, focusing on insecticide resistance mechanisms of agricultural pests in the tropics: specifically, fall armyworm resistance to Bt proteins. She aims to develop novel strategies that will improve insect resistance management and mitigate or delay resistance to Bt crops.

Erick Martínez is a visiting scholar for Drs. Peter Piermarini and Luis Cañas, doing behavioral experiments with the yellow-fever mosquito *Aedes Aegypti* and greenhouse pest management.
